



INFORMATION TO CUSTOMERS

This information is provided to customers / suppliers natural persons and natural persons who operate in the name and on behalf of customers / suppliers legal entities, of the company **LM MORTARI S.R.L.** pursuant to Art. 13 GDPR 679/2016 – "European Regulation on the protection of personal data".

Data Controller

The Data Controller is **LM MORTARI S.r.l.**, with registered office in Loc. Campogrande 6/B - 29013 Carpaneto Piacentino (PC) in the person of its Legal Representative.

Purpose of the processing

The personal data of customers / suppliers natural persons, if provided, are processed by the Data Controller for:

- execution of obligations deriving from a contract of which you are a party or to fulfill, before or after the execution of the contract, your specific requests;
- fulfillment of legal obligations of an administrative, accounting, civil, fiscal, regulations, community and non-EU regulations;
- customer management (acquisition of pre-contractual data and information, customer administration, reliability and solvency control for the prevention of possible fraud, insolvencies and / or defaults, administration of contracts, orders, shipments and invoices);
- management of litigation (breach of contract, warnings, transactions, debt collection, arbitration, judicial disputes).

Recipients of the data

The personal data processed by the Data Controller will not be disseminated, or will not be disclosed to indeterminate subjects, in any possible form, including that of their provision or simple consultation. Instead, they may be communicated to workers who work for the Data Controller and to some external subjects who collaborate with them. They may also be communicated, within the limits strictly necessary, to subjects who, for the purpose of processing orders or other requests or services relating to the transaction or the contractual relationship with the Data Controller, must provide goods and / or perform services on behalf of the Data Controller. Finally, they may be communicated to persons entitled to access them by virtue of legal provisions, regulations, community regulations.

In particular, on the basis of the roles and work tasks performed, some workers have been legitimized to process personal data, within the limits of their skills and in accordance with the instructions given to them by the Data Controller.

Data transfer

The data controller may carry out a transfer of data to a third country or to international organizations in relation to the need to use computerized systems of the company whose structure and database may reside outside the borders of the state, in order to allow the processing of the request of the interested party. Rights of the interested party

Withdrawal of consent

With reference to art. 6 of the GDPR 679/16, the interested party may revoke any consent given at any time. However, the processing covered by this information is lawful and permitted, even in the absence of consent, as it is necessary for the execution of a contract to which the interested party is a party (the service supply relationship) or for the fulfillment of his requests.

Complaint

The interested party has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority of the state of residence.

Refusal to provide data

The provision of data is mandatory on the basis of legal obligations, regulatory regulations and conditioning the possibility of correctly and effectively fulfilling the contractual obligations assumed.

The provision of additional personal data may be necessary to improve the quality and efficiency of the transaction.
